## **NEWS OF THE DAY**

- Today it was confirmed that a member of the CMU Pittsburgh campus community has been diagnosed with the COVID-19 virus. We continue to take precautions and take this situation extremely seriously. Please comply with all instructions and advisories you receive to help in our campus-wide efforts to reduce impacts of the coronavirus on our campus. This takes extra effort from all of us, and I truly appreciate your cooperation.
- We escalated the move of research operations to remote locations, based on the Pennsylvania Governor's order late yesterday. This work continues as I write.
- We have academic continuity liaisons for each SCS department; we'll soon be sharing the research liaisons for each SCS department on the SCS Alerts page.
- We are also working to assure our teaching infrastructure remains in top working order.

### **QUESTIONS FROM AROUND SCS**

- Should staff be working? Yes. Remotely. CMU remains open and fully operational, but operating remotely until further notice.
- Can I go to campus if I want to? By now, you should be working remotely, and that will remain how we operate until further notice.

#### **OF NOTE**

— Although we're working remotely, safe working conditions are essential and must be assured for all employees. If you've relocated equipment to a remote location, it must operate as safely in its new location as it has operated on campus. Along the same lines, I want to emphasize that student workers should never feel pressured to work in an environment they may feel is unsafe.
